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The Global Initiative Against HPV and Cervical Cancer (GIAHC) Young Leaders program is proud to introduce the **GIAHC Young Leaders Grant**, a **\$500** monetary award for students, researchers, advocates, or community activists interested in raising awareness about cervical cancer prevention.

## **Who is eligible?**

Individuals  $\leq 30$  years of age are eligible to submit a proposal for consideration.

## **How do I apply?**

Complete the application and submit electronically via email to [chair@giahcyl.org](mailto:chair@giahcyl.org) no later than **5 pm EST on June 20, 2022**. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

## **Letter of Support**

One letter of support is required from a mentor or supervisor. The letter of support should highlight the following:

- Information regarding your relationship with the applicant and your evaluation of the applicant's capability to carry out the proposed project
- The extent to which appropriate mentoring and support is in place
- The extent to which you support the proposed project and believe it to be of educational value

## **Progress Reports and Presentations**

Those receiving funding through this application must submit a 2-3 page progress report on their work by **December 31, 2022**. A final, 2-3 page report is also expected at project completion or by **July 31, 2023**, whichever comes first. Report guidelines will be provided to grantees after award receipt. Any publications or public presentations resulting from the work should be shared with [chair@giahcyl.org](mailto:chair@giahcyl.org) to be featured on GIAHC social media channels.

## **IRB Approval**

If your summer project involves human subjects, you must indicate in your application narrative the name of the IRB reviewing the project and where in the approval process the project currently stands. For human subjects, this includes data collection from living individuals through interaction or intervention, or data collection of identifiable, private information through secondary data analysis. Final IRB approval must be in place before funding will be distributed.
